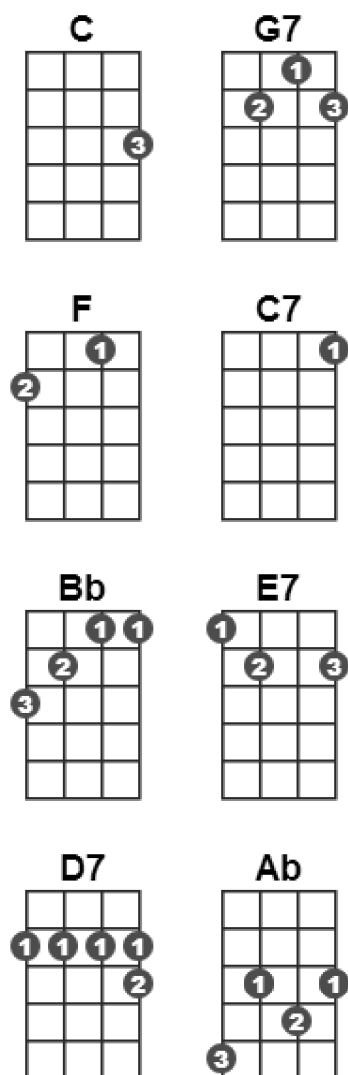


Chattanooga Choo Choo
