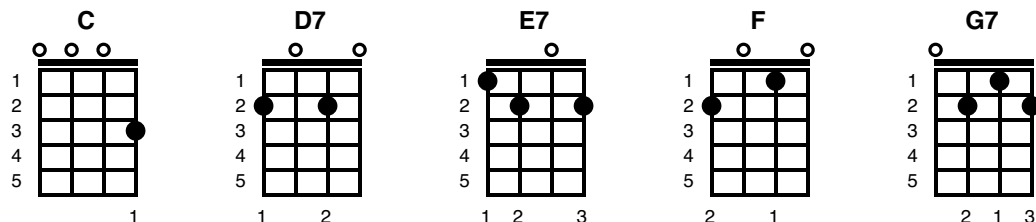


Bad Bad Leroy Brown
