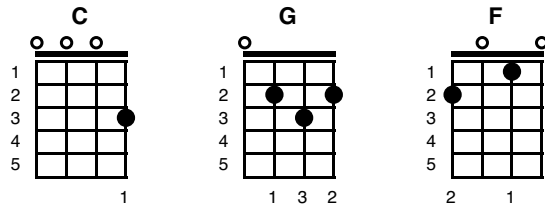


# Wilder Than Her
