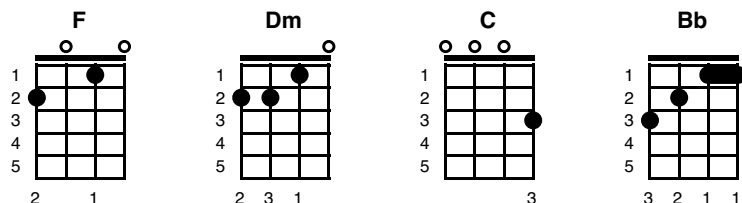


# Farewell To Nova Scotia
